

## APPENDIX A

### STARTING TIME RESERVATION PROCEDURE

1. Telephone 01655 334 048 – a direct line to the Reservation Office.
2. Give name and indicate Membership of Turnberry Golf Club.
3. Members may make a reservation for any day of the week, provided it is not more than 17 days prior to actual date of play. However, when booking on Wednesdays for 17 days out, reservations will only be taken from 1.30pm.
4. The reservation should be made under the Member's name and an indication of the numbers playing and the number of caddies required.
5. **Members must make cancellations 24 hours in advance of the starting time. This is very important and is being monitored by the Hotel.**
6. **Any Member playing golf must secure a tee time and a receipt from the Pro Shop before going to the tee. If you do not you may be asked to leave the course at any time.**
7. When booking a tee time only one tee time per Member is allowed. No multiple, one name bookings, will be permitted.
8. All Guests must be signed in at the Pro Shop prior to teeing off.

## APPENDIX B

1. Allocated Members' times have been booked on the Ailsa Course between 6.30am and 7.30am on every Saturday and Sunday (light permitting, apart from a few days that have been previously booked).
  2. Allocated Members' times have been booked on the Kintyre Course between 6.30am and 9.00am and 12.30pm and 2.00pm every Saturday and between 6.30am and 9.00am and 12.30pm and 1.30pm every Sunday (light permitting, apart from a few days that have been previously booked).
  3. If the allocated Members' times at the weekends are not taken ten days out they will revert back to open times for anyone to book. The Hotel may, from time to time, need to book over Members' times. If this happens additional times will be added during the day to ensure the total numbers of allocated times remains the same.
  4. Junior Members can book times only one day in advance on the Kintyre Course but up to seven days in advance on the Arran Course. Juniors must be accompanied by an adult TGC Member if playing the Ailsa Course.
- All items above will be reviewed as the season passes and may change in consultation with the Club Captain.

## APPENDIX C

### **The Golf Academy**

1. TGC Playing Members are entitled to use the practice facilities during normal opening hours with unlimited golf balls to hit.
2. TGC Playing Members must check in with a member of the Academy staff and notify them of their intentions.
3. The Academy staff reserves the right to ask any Member to move position within the Academy or cease to practice at any time. The covered bays within the Academy are designed to be used for warm up purposes before play. If a Member wishes to have extended practice session they should notify the Academy staff. It will be at the discretion of the staff whether it is feasible to extend the practice session while accommodating other golfers who wish to use the facility.
4. Membership does give the use of the Ailsa or Arran teaching rooms, the Monty Room or the Culzean Room within the Academy.
5. Academy range balls only to be used in the facility.
6. Balls may be hit between 7.00am and 7.00pm (summer) and 8.00am to 1 hour before dusk (winter). This may vary due to the weather or any other reason.
7. If TGC Members wishes to hit balls off grass they must inform the Academy staff who will give them permission and directions to use the far end of the practice area. (It is not permissible to take your car to the far end of the range).
8. Members' guests playing on one of the Turnberry Courses will be permitted to hit warm up balls before their round provided they have been signed in at the Pro Shop.
